This information is provided as a status report of potential Amherst County stimulus fund projects that were submitted to the Governor's Office in March 2009. As you recall the Board had a special work session on June 4, 2009 which was attended by Delegate Shannon Valentine and Barbara Reese of the Governor's Office. Following is a list of projects for which funding was requested at that time and status for each.

- 1) Riverbank stabilization – eligible but no funding provided
- 2) Water & sewer extension to Rt. 210 – eligible but no funding provided
- 3) Admin Building entrances – not eligible
- 4) Picnic shelters at Coolwell – not eligible
- 5) Basketball court repairs – not eligible
- 6) Goodwin Building renovation – not eligible
- 7) Riveredge Park – funding may be available through transportation enhancement grants
- 8) Train Depot – funding may be available through transportation enhancement grants
- 9) Madison Heights sidewalks – funding may be available through transportation enhancement grants
- 10) Old Madison drainage and utility needs – funding may be available through DHCD
- 11) Recycling Facility – not eligible

Two stimulus projects have been awarded to the Sheriff's Dept – one in the amount of \$32,000 for safety equipment and the other in the amount of \$50,000 for vehicles.

A grant application has recently been submitted for a joint school/county facilities energy efficiency study to the Department of Mines and Minerals and of course the Broadband Authority is producing significant effort in preparation of a stimulus application.
