CONCLUSION:

The purpose of this report is to compare both the approved public utility units of the past five years, plus the current year, and to provide a historical perspective, vs. the numbers of public utility units currently being proposed. It is not possible for it to predict which projects will succeed, nor within what time frame that would occur. Yet, if only 66% of the proposed utility units should become reality the number of water units would be 125% higher than those approved in the previous five years. If 66% of the proposed sewer units are approved, this would be 110% higher than the prior years. Approval of 66% would ultimately result in a 2.9% increase in ACSA's water accounts and a 12.7% increase in sewer customers.
