## 3. PUBLIC HEARIING - SPECIAL EXCEPTION

A. Zoning Case # 2011-22

Request by William Page Jr., for a special exception request in the B-2 General Commercial District. The purpose of the special exception is to allow an automotive repair garage. The property is located at 3975 South Amherst Highway and is further identified as tax map number 155-A-128.

Mr. Bryant presented to the Planning Commission the staff report. Mr. Bryant stated that if the Planning Commission were to approve the request, staff recommended conditions are as follows:

- 1. All outdoor lighting will be glare-shielded and directed so as to prevent illumination across the property line.
- 2. No miscellaneous items such as, but not limited to: tires, automotive parts, tools or similar items related to automotive repair shall be stored outside the building.
- 3. Hours of operation:
  - i. Monday Saturday 7AM 7 PM
  - ii. Closed on Sunday
- 4. Prior to the issuance of a zoning permit, the applicant shall contact the Virginia Department of Transportation to determine if the existing entrances will require further review and to determine if they are adequate.
- 5. If an exterior trash disposal facility is added, it shall not reduce the number of total parking spaces below the eight (8) that are required. Trash disposal facilities shall meet all screening requirements as set forth in the Amherst County Landscaping Ordinance.

Mr. Brine asked if anything would be stored outside of the building. Mr. Bryant replied that no storage would be permitted outside; however vehicles that had been repaired would be parked outside until customers came to pick up.

Mr. Heishman opened the public hearing.

Mr. Paige, the applicant, stated that he agreed with the conditions.

No one spoke in favor or in opposition of the request.

There being no further speakers, Mr. Heishman closed the public hearing.
