#### 4. PUBLIC HEARING – SPECIAL EXCEPTION

A. 2015-06 Miller's Auto Body & Paint Shop (Tax Map # 124-6-2)

Request by Miller's Auto Body & Paint shop for a special exception request in the B-2 General Commercial District. The purpose of the special exception is to allow an automotive repair garage and paint shop. The parcel is located at 2265 South Amherst Highway and is further identified as tax map number 124-6-2.

Mr. Bryant presented the Staff report and concluded his comments by stating that Staff recommends the following conditions.

- 1. All outdoor lighting will be glare-shielded and directed to prevent illumination across the property line.
- 2. No miscellaneous items, such as, but not limited to: tires, automotive parts, tools or similar items related to automotive repair shall be stored outside building.
- 3. Hours of operation:
  - i. Monday Saturday 7AM 7PM
  - ii. Closed on Sunday
- 4. Prior to the issuance of a zoning permit, the applicant shall contact the Virginia Department of Transportation to determine if the existing entrances are safe and adequate.
- 5. Prior to the issuance of a zoning permit, the applicant shall contact the Department of Health to determine if the drainfield is adequate.
- 6. If an exterior trash disposal facility is added, it shall be screened by a solid wooden fence that fully shields the view of the trash disposal facility.
- 7. All vehicles waiting repair shall be placed in a designated parking area. The maximum time any vehicle can be on the parcel is 120 days.

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Ms. Jones opened the public hearing.

No one spoke in favor or opposition to the request; therefore, Ms. Jones closed the public hearing.

The Planning Commission had a brief discussion and asked if the house on the property could still be used as a residence. Mr. Bryant replied that it would be left as a residence.

#### 5. OLD/NEW BUSINESS

Staff was directed by the Planning Commission at the Planning Commission meeting on July 16, 2015 to survey other localities and how they determine and permit personal wireless service facilities on school property.

Mr. Mitchell presented a memorandum that stated that the response from Bedford County, Campbell County, Lynchburg City, and Nelson County was that cell towers on school properties would follow the same procedure and regulations for towers on any other property in the same zoning district as the school; therefore there are no special regulations for school properties. The memorandum also stated that there are currently no personal wireless service facilities, specifically cell towers, on school properties in Campbell or Nelson Counties. Bedford County has one cell tower and Lynchburg City has three or four cell towers on school properties.
