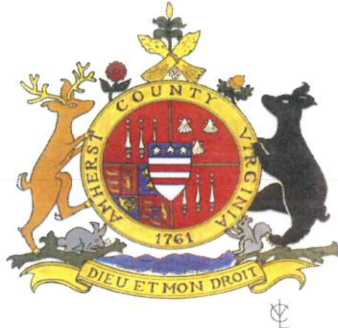

8. Revised Composite Index


**III. Adjourn**
