Amherst County Public Schools in partnership with WSET to broadcast lessons starting June 8.

Amherst County Public Schools is proud to announce the release of educational lessons on WSET's alternate channel 13.2. These lessons are designed for all age groups and include lessons in reading, math, science, social studies, career-technical education, social emotional learning, and many more.

ACPS teacher, counselors, and administrators worked with Nelson County to record a total of 95 lessons. These prerecorded lessons allow students to remain engaged and connected during the summer months. Superintendent Dr. Rob Arnold says he is hopeful "this becomes another means for parents and students to access educational information. We hope that students all across the WSET viewing area can take advantage of this unique project."

Lesson topics are organized daily and are time specific. Monday lesson's will be math focused while Tuesday's lesson will concentrate on literacy. Wednesday and Thursday lessons will cover science with social emotional learning and history with social sciences respectively. Elementary lessons air from 12 p.m. – 1p.m., middle, 1p.m.-2 p.m., and highschool specific lessons will 2p.m.-5p.m.

Hour long lessons will be broadcasted over air on channel 13.2. Xfinity customers can also access lessons via channel 205 or 1170 from June 8 - July 17, Monday - Thursday from 12 p.m. to 5 p.m
