A RESOLUTION, NO. 2022-0002-R

A resolution, amending the Amherst County Grant Fund budget as a part of the Amherst County Budget for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 and adoption of the American Rescue Plan Act Spending Plan.

Approved as to form and legality by the Amherst County Attorney

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF AMHERST, VIRGINIA:

I. That the Amherst County Board of Supervisors ("Board") amends the 2021-2022 County Budget for the Grant Fund and adopts the American Rescue Plan Act Spending Plan with expenditures in the amount of \$6,138,901, as follows:

WHEREAS, the County Administrator has submitted to the Amherst County Board of Supervisors the proposed American Rescue Plan Act Spending Plan and a proposed budget amendment for the County for fiscal year 2021-2022 ("County Budget"); and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the proposed American Rescue Plan Act Spending Plan and the proposed budget amendment to the County Budget and has been apprised of the availability of funds to support the proposed expenditures; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to adopt the American Rescue Plan Act Spending Plan and a proposed budget amendment for the County Budget and appropriate funds to support the requirements therein; and

WHEREAS, the Board held a public hearing, properly noticed in accordance with Virginia law, on the proposed American Rescue Plan Act Spending Plan and the proposed budget amendment for fiscal year 2022 County Budget, on February 15, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Board now intends to adopt as part of the County Budget the American Rescue Plan Act Spending Plan and a proposed budget amendment fiscal year 2021-2022 Grant Fund budget, and appropriate the funds therein on an annual basis and by line.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF AMHERST, VIRGINIA:

That the Amherst County Board of Supervisors adopts the American Rescue Plan Act Spending Plan and the proposed budget amendment for the 2021-2022 County Grant Fund budget as part of the County Budget and said funds are appropriated as follows:
