The session will be held in the Amherst County Administrative Conference Room at 153 Washington Street unless otherwise noted in the syllabus.

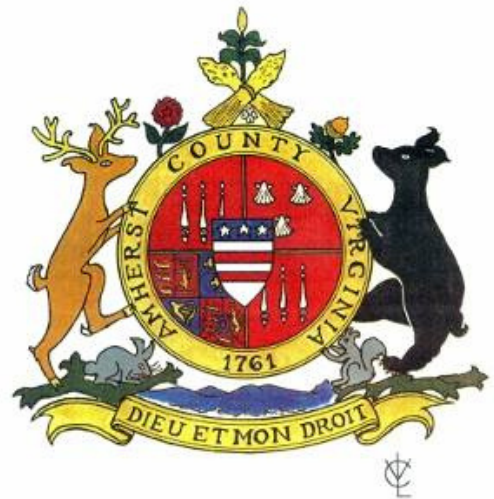


WHO
