4. BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS REQUEST

A. 2015A-01 Wingfield/Irvin (Tax Map #136-A-93)

Request by C.T. Wingfield, agent for Mr. & Mrs. James C. Irvin, for approval of a variance from Section 804(a) of the Amherst County Zoning & Subdivision Ordinance to reduce the setback from the boundary line of land within the P-1 Public Lands District, owned in conjunction with any current or designated future site of a lake or reservoir by the Amherst County Service Authority, from two hundred (200) feet to seventy (70) feet, to allow for the construction of a single-family dwelling. The request is referenced by a drawing submitted by the applicant. The property is zoned R-1 Limited Residential District and is located adjacent to 249 Graham Creek Rd (Route 676) and is further identified as tax map number 136-A-93.

Mr. Mitchell presented the Staff report and concluded his comments by stating that should the Board of Zoning Appeals approve this request; Staff recommends the following conditions:

- 1. The variance is granted for Tax Map Parcel No. 136-A-93 to reduce the setback from the boundary line of land within the P-1 Public Lands District, owned in conjunction with any current or designated future site of a lake or reservoir by the Amherst County Service Authority, from two hundred (200) feet to seventy (70) feet, to allow for the construction of a single-family dwelling.
- 2. The granting of this variance shall not be construed to vest in the applicant a right to the variance until all necessary local, State and Federal plan application, review and approval processes have been completed.
- This approval may be revoked by the County of Amherst or its designated agent for failure by the applicant or its assigns to comply with any of the listed conditions or any provision of Federal, State or local regulations.
