Summary: The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) has asked Amherst County to declare April 3-7, 2017 as Work Zone Awareness Week by resolution. In Virginia in 2015, there were 2,600 work zone crashes resulting in 1,416 injuries and seven fatalities. The purpose of the resolution is to create more public awareness of work zone safety in the county during the National Work Zone Safety Awareness Week.

WHEREAS, the VDOT Workers Memorial on Afton Mountain bears the names of 134 Virginia Department of Transportation employees who gave their lives in service to Virginians.
