THE COUNTY OF AMHERST HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That Section 9-4 to the Code of the County of Amherst be and hereby is added as follows:

Sec. 9-4. – Assessment of electronic summons system.


- (a) Pursuant to Section 17.1-279.1 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, there is hereby imposed and assessed a fee of \$5 as part of the costs in each criminal and traffic case in the District and Circuit Courts within the County.
- (b) The Clerk of the Court in which the action is filed shall collect these assessments and remit them to the County Treasurer.
- (c) The Treasurer shall hold the funds subject to appropriation by the Board of Supervisors to the Sheriff's office solely to fund software, hardware, and associated equipment costs for the implementation and maintenance of an electronic summons system.

§ 2. That this ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
