A. Tiffany Alcock Special Exception

Planning/Zoning Director Bryant reported on a special exception request submitted by Tiffany Alcock for a bed and breakfast and a venue for weddings and special events. Ms. Alcock's property is located at 2816 Lowesville Road, and identified as tax map number 29-A-14.

Mr. Bryant explained that bed and breakfast businesses are a permitted use in an Agricultural District, however, this property is zoned Village District and does require a special exception.

On September 20, 2018 the Planning Commission recommended approval of the special exception with six conditions:

- 1. <u>Transportation</u>: Prior to the issuance of a zoning permit, the applicant shall contact the Virginia Department of Transportation to determine if the existing entrances are safe and adequate.
- 2. <u>Drainfield</u>: Prior to the issuance of a zoning permit, the applicant shall contact the Virginia Department of Health to determine if the drainfield is adequate for the proposed combined uses.
- 3. <u>Lighting:</u> All outdoor lighting will be glare-shielded and directed so as to prevent illumination across the property line.
- 4. <u>Parking:</u> A parking attendant shall be directing traffic with events greater than seventy-five (75) guests.
- 5. <u>Noise:</u> All noise shall be in compliance with Chapter 10, Article II of the noise ordinance.
- 6. <u>Building</u>: The structure shall meet the Virginia Statewide Building Code or any other applicable regulations as approved by the Building Official.

## B. Transfer Request for Grant Fund

Finance Director Stacey Wilkes reported while working with the current fiscal year, she discovered that the Grant fund would require a transfer of \$296,334 from the unobligated General fund to bring it into balance.

Since 2007, Ms. Wilkes said she found some grants that had funds, however, the local match that paid for those expenses was never recorded into the Grant fund. In order to correct the error, it would be necessary to appropriate \$296,334 from the unobligated General fund and move that money to the specified account. Those corrections have been coordinated with the auditors, and the transfer will reduce the General fund unobligated balance.

Supervisor Pugh said this is an example of unforeseen items that come up during the year where money has to be taken from the unobligated general fund, and stressed the importance of being more conservative.
