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Second Street Farmers' Market ready to kick off 7th season with new manager

Second Street Farmers' Market, run by Second Stage | Amherst is set to kick off its 7th season on May 23rd with a new manager at the helm.

Crystal Ungar, a local artisan, owns and manages Once Upon a Peacock where she and her husband Andy restore and refinish antique furniture from their home at Sweet Water Farm in Amherst. She is also a homeschooling mom of four and passionate about organic, locally grown food.

The market will feature locally grown and produced meats and produce as well as baked goods, fresh flowers, and items created by local artisans. New this year, Ungar has removed the booth fee, instead charging a flat 10% so that local vendors with fewer items for sale will be better able to realize a profit at the end of the day.

Another innovation for 2019 is a shared table where locally grown and produced items can be dropped off to be sold by a member of the market staff or a volunteer. This is in response to people who aren't able to attend the market, as well as those who only have a small amount to sell which doesn't warrant a whole booth.
