Clerk's Office, under prevailing conditions, would constitute a threat to the health and safety of

is appropriately cleaned and disinfected; and

NOW, THEREOFRE, this Court, pursuant to Va. Code § 17.2-207(A)(3), hereby

ORDERS with the consent of the Clerk that the Amherst Circuit Court Clerk's office and the

Amherst Circuit Court shall be closed at Noon on February 4, 2021 and all day on February 5,

2021 to allow the office to be appropriately cleaned and disinfected. The closing of the Amherst

Circuit Court and the Amherst Clerk's office shall have the same effect as provided in subsection

B of Va. Code § 1-210.

Attorney, Lynchburg Bar Association and to post a copy of this Order at the courthouse entrance.
