IV. Monthly Financial Report

A. September 2016

Mr. French addressed the Board and advised he has seen a slow but steady increase in new water and sewer connections for this year. Mr. French said they have had 36 new water connections and 15 new sewer connections and he continues to see a slow recoup from the recession.

V. Proposed ACSA C.Y. 2017 Budget

Mr. French addressed the Board and explained the several items listed on the budget. The Board discussed items regarding wage reporting, water and sewer charges for Central Virginia Training Center and pending closure and Mr. French's retirement in 2017.

VI. Alternative Grant Funding Of Future OTMH Utility Work, To Make The Proposed CDBG Application More Competitive

Mr. French addressed the Board and explained that utilities can now be only a small portion of grant funding since the funds available for Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) are severely limited. Mr. French explained the sewer line rehabilitation work could be broken out into separate "Construction Ready" CDBG utilities grant applications.

Mr. French asked the Board to allow the Service Authority to take a position to proceed with the engineering work and then apply for the first "Construction Ready" CBDG and a second or third grant application as necessary.

By motion of Vice-Chair Pugh and with the following vote, the Board authorized ACSA staff to prepare the \$77,000 appropriation request and authorize the necessary engineering design and

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grant application. Mr. French will return with the amended 2017 budget lines for these appropriations next month.
