BOARD MEETING
May 14, 2018

The Amherst County Parks, Recreation & Cultural Development Board held its monthly meeting on May 14 2018 at 6:30PM at Monroe Community Center.

The following members were present: Roni Tuggle, Christy Kreuziger, JoJo Allcock and Stevie Angus. Also in attendance was Sara Lu Christian

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Stevie Angus.

Stevie made a motion to approve the agenda, Christy seconded the motion. Motion carried

JoJo made a motion to approve April minutes, Stevie seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Carter Massie approached the board to discuss mountain biking trails in Amherst County. He is an avid mountain biker and is eager to have mountain bike trails constructed in the county. He is also meeting with the town to look at the options there. The Board expressed their total support in this effort. No action was taken.

The Board reviewed the senior social calendar and reports, and bingo reports. Today was the second Social for Seniors for the 2018 calendar year and held at the Madison Heights Community Center. There were roughly 208 seniors in attendance.

The Board also reviewed the community centers calendar, and theme park and night fishing license reports.

There was more discussion on a Virginia is for Lovers "LOVE" sign at Riveredge Park. The Board members are to bring some ideas for design to the next meeting.

Sara Lu reported that the picnic tables at all of the county lakes have been repaired. The work was done by the Sheriff Department's work crew. They also replaced the roof on the bathroom at Thrashers Lake.

Sara Lu reported that she will be requesting funding to replace the playgrounds at Thrashers, Stonehouse and Coolwell Park from the Board of Supervisors.
