Sara Lu reported that the Board of Supervisors passed a resolution naming the portion of the Virginia Blue Ridge Railway trail, between Rose Mill and the Tye River Bridge, "The Popie and Steve Martin Corridor of the Virginia Blue Ridge Railway Trail" at their March 17th meeting.

Sara Lu also reported that the Board of Supervisors passed a resolution supporting adding the boat ramp at Snowden to the James River Water Trail at their March 17th meeting.
