Zoning Case 2005-07

Request by Ronal Adams for Madison Heights Baseball for a conditional zoning to B-2 General Commercial District from R-2 General Residential District to M-1 Industrial District. The proposed rezoning is to allow a community center available for public and private events. The parcel is located off Woody's Lake Road, and is further identified by tax map number 156-A-120

At a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors held at the Administration Building thereof on Tuesday, the 21st day of June, 2005 at 7:30 p.m. the request was approved with the following proffers:

- 1. This building will be used as a community building. It will be rented for wedding receptions, banquets, business seminars, birthday parties, etc. As well as meetings for MHYBA.
- 2. Any event held at this locations will not extend past midnight.
- 3. Any even scheduled that has alcoholic beverages provided will be require to hire off-duty deputies from the Amherst County Sheriff's Office for the entire times of the event.
- 4. The facility will be gated during anytime it is not in use. There will be a locked gate at the entrance.
- 5. There will be no lighted signs on the premises.
- 6. The parking lot will be with directional, low illuminating lights that will not allow the light to interfere with the neighbors property.
- 7. MHYBA would meet any landscaping ordinance that Amherst County requires.
- 8. MHYBA will plant Leland Cyprus or white pine trees around the boarders of the property for privacy purposes.
- 9. The property will be checked daily for trash pick-up if necessary, grounds maintenance such as grass mowing and leaf pick up.
- 10. Before any construction is started, directors of MHYBA would host community meeting to hear any suggestions and concerns of the neighbors to try and make this property neighbor friendly and a good working relationship with surrounding property owners.
- 11. No other uses permitted in the B-2 zone will be employed.
