CULTURAL DEVELOPMENT  
BOARD MEETING  
April 11, 2011

The Amherst County Parks, Recreation and Cultural Development Board held its monthly meeting on April 11, 2011, at 6:45 PM in the Board of Supervisors room in the County Administration Building.

The following members were present: Chairman Roni Tuggle, Heather Follett, and Gary Evans. Also in attendance was Sara Lu Christian.

The meeting was called to order by Gary Evans as deferred by Chairperson, Roni Tuggle due to loss of voice.

A motion was made by Heather and seconded by Roni to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Roni made a motion to accept the March minutes as presented. Gary seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Gary made a motion to accept the March bills as presented. Heather seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Sara Lu provided a report on the county's 250<sup>th</sup> Birthday Festival taking place on Saturday, April 30<sup>th</sup>, at Amherst County High School from 11AM until the fireworks finale. Volunteers are still needed to assist with the event. There are currently 7 food vendors, as well as 25 craft and display vendors, in addition to the performers as listed in last month's minutes. Added to which, this list of partners/sponsors continues to grow.

Next, Sara Lu provided the revenue report, as well as the senior centers reports. She informed the Recreation Board that Murrell Thomas is seeking to retire and the search for his replacement is underway. It was suggested that we recognize Mr. Thomas for his years of service at the next board meeting.
