

**AMHERST COUNTY
PUBLIC NOTICE**

The Amherst County Board of Zoning Appeals (“BZA”) is responsible for conducting public hearings of 1) appeals of administrative decisions made by the Zoning Administrator, 2) applications for variances which are regulated by the Zoning Ordinance, and 3) for interpretation of the Zoning Map where there is uncertainty as to the location of a zoning district boundary. The Board is comprised of five (5) members appointed by the Amherst County Circuit Court to five (5) year terms. There is an at-large opening on the Board of Zoning Appeals. The Board of Supervisors will consider applications to fill this seat in order to make a final recommendation to the Amherst County Circuit Court.
