Planning Starts for Former CVTC Facilities

Amherst County is working with the Lynchburg Regional Business Alliance to launch the Training Center Redevelopment Plan with the aim to redevelop the Central Virginia Training Center.

A website has been created to allow the community to follow the planning process and provide input to the committee. Creating a Redevelopment Plan will help guide policy makers, developers, and stake holders in the future. All parties involved are working hard to create a space that will add value to both the Madison Heights and Lynchburg regional communities.

The next step in the redevelopment process is inviting the community to provide input to the project team. This will provide the project team with an understanding of what the community hopes to see and assist the planners as they determine the future growth and development of the Training Center site.

The Alliance received a GO Virginia grant in the amount of \$100,000 to assist in the execution of a redevelopment plan.
