ROUND DANCING is choreographed ballroom dancing in which, like square dancing, the dance sequence is called or cued. Hence, dancers learn figures and all couples aim to execute the same steps in a circle (thus the name "round dancing"). Round dancing is easier than ballroom dancing because dancers do not need to memorize long sequences of dance steps. Learn to dance WALTZ, FOXTROT, RUMBA, CHA CHA, TANGO, JIVE, TWO STEP, and more with a variety of dance sequences composed by the world's most imaginative choreographers. Round dancing has six levels (called "phases") of increasing figure vocabulary so that participants can choose to dance choreographies within their skill-level. Round dancing is suitable for all ages, including youth age 10 and up when accompanied by a parent or responsible adult.
