## **Paranormal Investigations at the Museum**

Amherst – On Sunday, October 6, starting at 2:30 p.m., come find out what members of Virginia Infinity Paranormal (VIP) discovered during their midnight adventure in the Kearfott/Wood house, 1886 log one-room log school house from the Madison Heights Duckbill plantation, and amongst the many artifacts in the Hamble Center. The group consists of paranormal investigators in Central Virginia, and they will tell of their findings and the equipment used the night of July 27<sup>th</sup> at the Museum.

VIP will also share stories of other investigations they have conducted, including Avenel in Bedford, The Exchange Hotel Civil War Medical Museum in Gordonsville, and the USS North Carolina Battleship. VIP has appeared on the television show *My Ghost Story* on the Biography Channel.

This program is open to the public. Admission fee is an interactive toy for a dog or cat; or a can of Purina kitten or puppy food for the Humane Society of Amherst County. Light refreshments will be provided.
